Neeraj Chpora Wins Silver

Star athlete Neeraj Chopra won India's sole silver medal in the Paris Games with a season's best throw of 89.45m in javelin on a day the hockey team had snatched its second successive Olympic bronze. While Chopra became the first Indian to win an Olympic gold and a silver in athletics, the event was dominated by Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem, who won gold with a massive throw of 92.97m. He secured Pakistan's first Olympic medal

since 1992.





Nagasaki Day

Nagasaki Day is an annual observance that commemorates one of the most devastating events in human history – the atomic bombing of <u>Nagasaki</u>, <u>Japan</u>, during World War II. Nagasaki Day is commemorated each year on August 9th, marking the exact date of the atomic bombing in 1945.

The theme for Nagasaki Day 2024 is: "Together with the Hibakusha, let us achieve a nuclear weapon-free, peaceful, and just world—for the future of humankind and our planet."





India's top three business families valued close to Singapore's GDP: Barclays-Hurun report

- India's top three business families Ambani, Bajaj, and Kumar Mangalam Birla are collectively worth more than \$460 billion, nearly matching Singapore's GDP.
- ➤ According to the 2024 Barclays Private Clients Hurun India Most Valuable Family Businesses report, the Ambani family's worth is pegged at Rs 25.75 Jakh crore, followed by the Bajaj family at Rs 7.13 Jakh crore and the Birla family at Rs 5.39 Jakh crore.



- The Adani Family, valued at Rs 15.45 lakh crore, is not among the top business families, as first-generation families have been excluded from the list. However, a separate ranking of first-generation families with active second-generation leaders has the Adani Family at the top, followed by the Poonawalla family, valued at Rs 2.37 lakh crore.
- The report analysed around 200 listed and unlisted companies and found that 75 percent of the firms are publicly traded, and the rest are unlisted. Haldiram Snacks (valued at Rs 63,000 crore) is the most valuable unlisted company, according to the list.



Muhammad Yunus Takes Oath as Head of Bangladesh's Interim Govt

Nobel laureate Muhammad Yunus late took oath as the head of the interim government of Bangladesh. The new caretaker government, led by its chief advisor Muhammad Yunus, was sworn in by President Mohammed Shahabuddin The development came three days after Sheikh Hasina was ousted as the Bangladesh prime minister following violent protests in

the country.



- ➤ Yunus, who was undergoing medical treatment in <u>Paris</u>, returned to <u>Bangladesh earlier in the day</u>. The president named Yunus the chief adviser of the interim government after student protesters recommended him for the role. Yunus won the Nobel Peace Prize in 2006 for his pioneering work on microlending.
- According to the <u>Dhaka Tribune</u>, diplomats from the <u>UK</u>, <u>China</u>, <u>Japan</u>, <u>Iran</u>, <u>the Philippines</u>, <u>Qatar</u>, <u>Argentina</u>, the Netherlands and the UAE were present at the swearing-in ceremony.



India's 4th medal in the Paris Olympics

- After the semi-final heartbeak against Germany, the Indian men's hockey team bounced back to end their Olympic campaign with a 2-1 win over Spain and clinch the bronze medal. This was India's 4th medal in the Paris Olympics.
- ► Harmanpreet (30th, 33rd minute) scored for India, while Spain's only goal was scored by captain Marc Miralles in the 18th minute from a penalty stroke.







- The medal was special for India goalkeeper PR Sreejesh since it was the final match of his hockey career. India has now won their second consecutive Olympic medal in hockey for the first time since 1972. Social media was flooded with congratulatory messages following the victory.
- For PR Sreejesh it was a fairytail ending to the international hockey career. For a man who served Indian hockey for 18-year-long years the final script couldn't have been much better. His exceptional performance throughout the tournament helped India overcome tough matches.



SEBI Approves Praveena Rai as New MD & CEO of MCX

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has approved Praveena Rai's appointment as the Managing Director and CEO of the Multi Commodity Exchange (MCX), India's largest commodity exchange.









What is the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, 2024?

The bill aims to restrict the power of Waqf boards to manage its properties and provides for more government regulation. The bill proposes to make registration with the District Collector's Office mandatory for any Waqf property, so that the property can be evaluated. The Union government's proposed amendment to the Waqf Boards Act 1995 has

sparked a political slugfest.







> Opposition parties allege that the proposals aim to deprive the Muslim community of their land, assets and the "freedom to manage religious affairs" guaranteed under Article 26 of the Indian Constitution. It refers to a moveable or immovable property dedicated in the name of god for charitable purposes by a deed or an instrument. The practice has been in existence even before the practice of documentation began. A Waqf property can either be for public charitable purposes or held private to benefit an individual's descendants. A Waqf property is non-transferable and held perpetually in the name of God.



ISRO's EOS-08 Satellite Launch

➤ The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is set to celebrate its 55th foundation day on August 15, 2024, with a significant milestone – the launch of the Earth Observation Satellite-08 (EOS-08). ISRO was established on August 15, 1969, as India's premier space agency. Currently, Dr. S. Somnath, is the Chairman of ISRO.


President Droupadi Murmu addresses the New Zealand International Education conference in Wellington

As of 31.03.2024, NCDC has disbursed Rs.6426.36 crore to women-led cooperative societies across India, although no proposals have been received from Bihar yet.


