



Haryana's MSP Policy

- The Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini declared the state govt's intention to purchase all crops at the Minimum Support Price (MSP), making Haryana the first state in the country to implement such a comprehensive MSP policy.
- Previously, only 14 crops were covered under the MSP scheme. Chief Minister Saini's announcement adds nine additional crops to this list, ensuring that farmers growing a wider variety of produce will benefit from the price protection offered by MSP.





NCW Launches Digital Shakti Center to Combat Cybercrimes Against Women

The National Commission for Women (NCW) has inaugurated the Digital Shakti Center in New Delhi to address the rising cybercrimes against women. This initiative aims to empower women with cyber safety knowledge, provide support for complaint registration, and create a safe digital environment. The NCW has been actively working to combat these crimes through the Digital Shakti campaign since 2018.






453 died while cleaning sewers since 2014: Govt

As per the records of Union Social Justice and Empowerment Ministry, 453 people died while cleaning sewers and septic tanks since 2014 even as 732 of India's 766 districts declared themselves free from manual scavenging.

The move to declare districts free from manual scavenging comes <u>under the framework of the Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013</u> which defines hazardous cleaning and manual scavenging in specific terms to ensure the safety and dignity of sanitation workers.







77-A of Registration Act struck down by Madras HC

The Madras High Court has declared Section 77-A of the Registration Act, 1908 unconstitutional. Section 77-A, introduced to the Central enactment by way of a 2022 State amendment, granted District Registrars the power to cancel documents related to immovable property if they were found to have been registered through fraud or on submission of forged revenue records.

The court expressed concern that District Registrars, as government servants, might show favoritism in disputes where the government has a rival claim. This lack of independence could compromise the fairness of the process.





India to Build Green Highways with World Bank Aid

The Government of India and the World Bank have joined forces to construct the Green National Highway Corridor Project (GNHCP). This project aims to build 781 km of ecofriendly highways across four states (Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, and Andhra Pradesh) with a focus on safety and climate resilience.


The World Bank will provide a loan of US \$500 million for the project, with a total cost of US \$1288.24 million (Rs. 7,662.47 crore).





10th National Handloom Day Celebrations on 7th August, 2024

The 10th National Handloom was celebrated 7th August 2024 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. Hon'ble Vice President of India was the Chief Guest on the occasion. During the function, Sant Kabir Awards and National Handloom Awards were conferred to handloom weavers for their outstanding contribution in handloom sector.







- Award Catalogue and Coffee Table Book-"Parampara- Sustainability in Handloom Traditions of India" was also released by the Hon'ble Vice President of India.
- Guided by the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister, the Government started celebrating National Handloom Day with the first such celebration being held on 7th August 2015.



- The date was specifically chosen to commemorate the Swadeshi Movement which was launched on 7th August 1905 and encouraged indigenous industries, particularly handloom weavers.
- National Handloom Day seeks to honour the handloom weavers and provide motivation and sense of pride to the handloom industry, by appreciating their contribution to the cultural, traditional and economic landscape of the country.



Maitri Grants by Australia

The Australian government has unveiled the Maitri Research and Cultural Partnerships Grants. These grants, aimed at fostering Australia-India collaboration, encompass sustainable manufacturing, energy transition research, and artistic projects.

The Maitri grants, administered by the Centre for Australia-India Relations, aim to deepen links and allow for closer collaboration between the two countries.

The five Maitri Research Grants will explore opportunities in agribusiness, critical technology, energy transition, and advanced manufacturing.



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India's First GI-Tagged Fig Juice Exported to Poland


Purandar Highlands has become the first company to export Indian fig juice to the European market It has also become the first to export commercial quantities of Purandar figs to Hong Kong. The exported products are made from Purandar figs, renowned for their taste, size, and nutritional value, which have earned a Geographical Indication (GI) tag.

India to host World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly 2024 in New Delhi

India is set to host the World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (WTSA) 2024 from October 15 to 24 at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi. The event will be preceded by the Global Standards Symposium (GSS) on October 14, as announced by the Department of Telecommunications (DoT).
